



2016 - 2017 Program Highlights

Big Brothers Big Sisters

Big Brothers Big Sisters SMART Program pairs high-school and middle-school students with elementary-aged students in order to provide bonding opportunities and skill building.

Middle School and High School Student Boards

YS CTC student boards are comprised of middle school and high school students and led by CTC advisory boards. These diverse groups seek greater understanding and tolerance of others while gaining leadership qualities needed to bring about positive change.

Cathy Shaffer Above & Beyond and Turnaround Awards

Each year, YS CTC honors, through the Cathy Shaffer Above & Beyond Awards, middle and high school student who exemplify the CTC mission. In addition, we recognize with our Turnaround Awards students who have made significant positive changes in their behaviors and attitudes during the school year.

New Family Inclusion

New Family Inclusion is a program that provides information and support to ease the transition for new families coming into York Suburban School District. We offer information about the district and its schools, as well as about the greater York area.

Kids in the Kitchen

We partner with Memorial Hospital to bring the "Kids in the Kitchen" program to East York Elementary and Indian Rock Elementary for interactive education about foods and nutrition.

National Night Out

In the 2016 - 2017 school year, we participated in "National Night Out," providing support as we worked to foster the relationship between law enforcement and our community.

Community Variety Show

The CTC Community Variety Show is our signature event, providing the opportunity for our community and schools to come together for a family-friendly event. Our November 2016 show featured 25 acts, and approximately 500 audience members were in attendance.

Dodgeball Tournament

Organized by the CTC High School Student Board, the Dodgeball Tournament engages our high school students in healthy fun and friendly competition. In March of 2017, ten teams of eight students each fought it out in an exciting night for all!

Multicultural Festival

The Multicultural Festival is a social and educational event at York Suburban Middle School, which provides exposure to diversity and encourages community involvement. Ten countries were represented through ethnic food, crafts, and games, and three groups provided musical and dance entertainment.

Wellness Fair

Working in collaboration with the the York Suburban Wellness committee, CTC organized a community Wellness Fair in May 2017 to promote health and wellness education .

Pennsylvania Youth Survey

In the fall of 2015, the Pennsylvania Youth Survey was given to 6th, 8th, 10th, and 12th grade York Suburban students. Given every two years, the survey assesses the risk factors affecting our youth. CTC uses this data to determine the programming best suited to address these factors. The 2017 survey data will be available in the spring of 2018.
